



Green Key

What is Green Key?

Green Key is a voluntary ecolabel awarded to more than 2600 hotels and other tourism establishments in 56 countries.



The ecolabel represents a commitment by businesses that their premises adhere to the strict criteria set out by the Foundation for Environmental Education. A Green Key stands for the promise to its guests that by opting to stay with the Green Key establishment, they are helping to make a difference on an environmental level. The high environmental standards expected of these establishments are maintained through rigorous documentation and frequent audits. Green Key is eligible for:

- Hotels and Hostels
- Campsites and Holiday Parks
- Small Accommodations
- Conference Centres
- Restaurants
- Attractions



Our aims

Increase the use of environmentally friendly technologies and sustainable methods of operation to make the most efficient use of resources.

Raise levels of environmental awareness among guests, staff and suppliers in the hospitality industry.

Create behavioural changes in the hospitality and tourism industry at large.

Our criteria



How are the establishments awarded?

Each Green Key applicant has to demonstrate compliance with our programme criteria which is subsequently verified by a third party.



Application. To be Green Key awarded, the applicant has to provide concrete proof of the compliance with our strict criteria.



Renewal. The Green Key award is only valid for one year and has to be renewed annually thereafter.



Decision making. The application is reviewed by a National Jury or the Green Key International Steering Committee.



Award. The successful applicants receive our Green Key Plaque and Certificate.



Audit. At a minimum, an on-site audit is conducted in years 1 & 2 and thereafter every third year.
