


#### SANI RESORT

#### Welcome to Sani Resort, Halkidiki, Greece

A world-class luxury destination, dedicated to preserving the environment

- · Five multiple award-winning 5\* hotels Sani Beach, Sani Club, Porto Sani, Sani Asterias and Sani Dunes
- · Nestled within a 1,000-acre ecological reserve
- · 7 private beaches and a private harbor, 10 Blue Flag awards
- · Sani Wetlands (Natura area) with 225 species of birds

#### Sani Resort Goals & Actions

#### Decrease water use and ensure clean wastewater

- $\cdot \text{Treated was tewater is used for garden irrigation in the resorts, from state-of-the-art was tewater treatment plants}\\$
- · Rooms and common areas are fitted with low-flowing water features (5lt/min for taps and 10lt/min for showers)
- · Continuous training of our staff on efficient water management
- Introduction of a zero-plastic strategy in order to reduce plastic pollution that ends up polluting water sources

#### Get our carbon footprint as close to zero as possible

- · Solar panels used for hot water production in Sani Beach
- · Sani Resort has been running on 100% renewable electricity since 2019 (with guarantee of origin certificates)
- · Sani Resort attained carbon neutral status for Scopes I&II, through investing in trustworthy renewable energy Clean Development Mechanism Projects (CDM) in the developing world certified by the United Nations

- $\cdot$  Adopted tailor made tools to monitor our performance with KPIs
- $\cdot$  All key suppliers are evaluated with sustainability criteria




#### SANI GREEN PROGRAMME



# THE ZERO-CARBON FOOTPRINT PROJECT

The company's aim to get its carbon footprint as close to zero as possible:

- · A project aiming to mitigate emissions, increase renewable energy use and offset remaining unavoidable emissions
- · In 2020, Sani Resort successfully became the first carbon neutral resort in Greece
- · Sani Resort has been running on 100% renewable electricity with a Guarantee of Origins certification since 2019



# A ROADMAP WITH MANY MILESTONES

Measurement of scope 1, and/or 2 and/or 3 emissions

Drafting of carbon reduction action plan including:

- · RES investment (primarily PV installation)

#### Step 3:



# TRIPLE ZERO PROJECT PROGRESS

#### Zero carbon footprint project

- · All electricity coming from renewable energy with GOs
- · Plan to turn buildings A class EPC implemented
- · Energy efficiency programme underway
- · Large RES investment programme in licensing phase (Phase I to cover over 30% of energy needs)
- · Conversion of fleet to EV begun
- · Scope 3 emissions measurement underway
- $\cdot$  Carbon neutral: all remaining Scope 1 & 2 emissions offset (ISO 14064)
- · CDM offsets by United Nations
- · Net zero target by 2030

### Zero plastic

- · Single-use plastic has been reduced by over 80% since 2013
- · Zero plastic front of house by 2022 (except covid measures)
- · Zero plastic kitchen pilot initiative underway
- · Zero plastic back of house by 2024

#### Zero waste

- · Over 50% of total waste generated recycled
- · Food waste elimination project underway
- · Initiatives across supply chain
- · Waste management procedures handle sorting at source, recycling of all packaging & hazardous waste
- · 100% composting of organic waste by 2023



### Protecting an award-winning eco paradise

· Water-saving meters installed on-site to reduce consumption

· Recycled water used for irrigation

· 100% of wastewater recycled


· 100% of all liquid waste is treated

Swimming waters have recorded no cases of algae, phytoplankton or other harmful nutrients which encourage eutrophication



# THE SANI WETLANDS PROJECT

The resort is adjacent to the Sani Wetlands, a Natura European Network area of Protected Natural Beauty. The Sani Wetlands project focuses on biodiversity protection and education. With an area of approximately 110 hectares, the wetlands are home to over 225 species of birds – almost half the total of bird species found in the whole of Greece – with many of them rare and globally endangered.



# FOREST PRESERVATION & PROTECTION


A dedicated Sani Forest team ensures the Sani Forest and its wildlife is protected. The team maintains kilometres of sign-posted forest trails to be experienced and enjoyed by guests and the local community. Other Sani Green initiatives include protecting local forests in the wider Halkidiki region. For example, the Plant a Tree program has grown and cared the last few years for over 10,000 trees in forests that were destroyed by devastating forest fires.

#### Sani is surrounded by old-growth forest

Mid-sized trees, contributing to the microclimate & preservation of biodiversity. Dominant species Allepo Pine Tree (Pinus halepensis)

#### It's home to many species of fauna

Insects, reptiles (Elaphe quatuorlineata), mammals e.g. red fox (Vulpes vulpes), hedgehogs (Erinaceidae), and the protected Greek tortoise (Testudo graeca)



#### THE SANI BEE SPOT

The Sani Bee Spot is the fruit of a collaboration between Sani Resort and The Bee Camp, the first Greek NGO focusing on the protection of pollinators.

The largest and first interactive Bee Spot in Greece, which aims to protect the bees and other pollinators found at Sani Resort.

#### An innovative bee-friendly garden

- 7 different stations, each dedicated to the life cycle of solitary bees:

Water Station

Herbal Garden

Pollinator Hotel



- · Documenting the resident dolphin species with ocean wildlife conservation organization iSea
- · Ongoing beach and underwater cleanups














# BIODIVERSITY AWARENESS PROGRAMMES

Guests have the opportunity to visit the onsite herb gardens and local wineries, go hiking, biking and birdwatching. We invite our guests to explore the unique biodiversity of each property, local products and customs. In 2019 alone, over 3,400 guests took part in a Sani eco-excursion during their stay, including the Sani Explorer activities for children and external excursions like beekeeping trips, olive harvesting and day farm trips.



### SUPPORTING A NETWORK OF ORGANISATIONS IN THE LOCAL COMMUNITY

- · Thought for Food Project: providing scholarships to local farmers to learn sustainable farming methods
- Supporting over 35 organisations, such as unaccompanied refugee hostels, schools, orphanages, and hospitals.
- · Past initiatives have included outfitting a local paediatric trauma unit, with over 18,000 kids so far benefiting from it, establishing a centre for abused women in Athens with the Salvation Army, renovating the kitchens of two Syrian unaccompanied refugee hostels up to a professional standard or supporting local families below the poverty line.
